

The European Master in Theoretical Chemistry and Computational Modelling (TCCM Master) has opened call for scholarships for pursuing master's studies during 2019-2021.

The programme is aimed at students from any region of the world who have obtained a bachelor degree in Chemistry, Physics or Material Science, or equivalent level if authorized by the legislation of the corresponding European Country, and have a minimum B2 English level.

Scholarships are offered by the following universities: Autonomous University of Madrid (Spain), University of Toulouse (France), and University of Valencia (Spain), and will cover tuition fees, travel and installation costs and a monthly subsistence allowance for the entire duration of the master studies.

For application, candidates should send to [emtccm@uam.es](mailto:emtccm@uam.es) ONE pdf file with all the following documents:

1. Letter of motivation, where the **three universities should be listed in order of preference**
2. CV
3. Copy of passport's page where your personal information is described
4. Proof of current place of residence, place of work, or study
5. Copy of transcript of records of bachelor's degree (copy TOR of master's degree too, if any)
6. Copy of diploma of bachelor's degree (copy of diploma of master's degree too, if any)
7. English official test results (such as TOEFL, IELTS, etc.), or any official document issued by your university which states your English language level
8. Two letters of recommendation (signed by referees)\*

\*Referees can send signed recommendation letters by themselves to [emtccm@uam.es](mailto:emtccm@uam.es).

*All documents should be translated into English (official translation is not mandatory)*
